

BRIDGING UNIT (1 of)

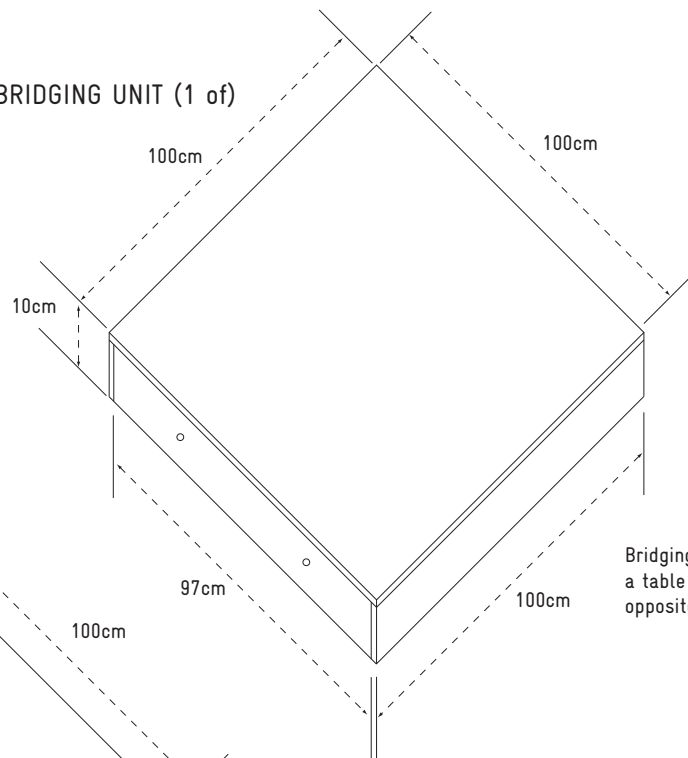
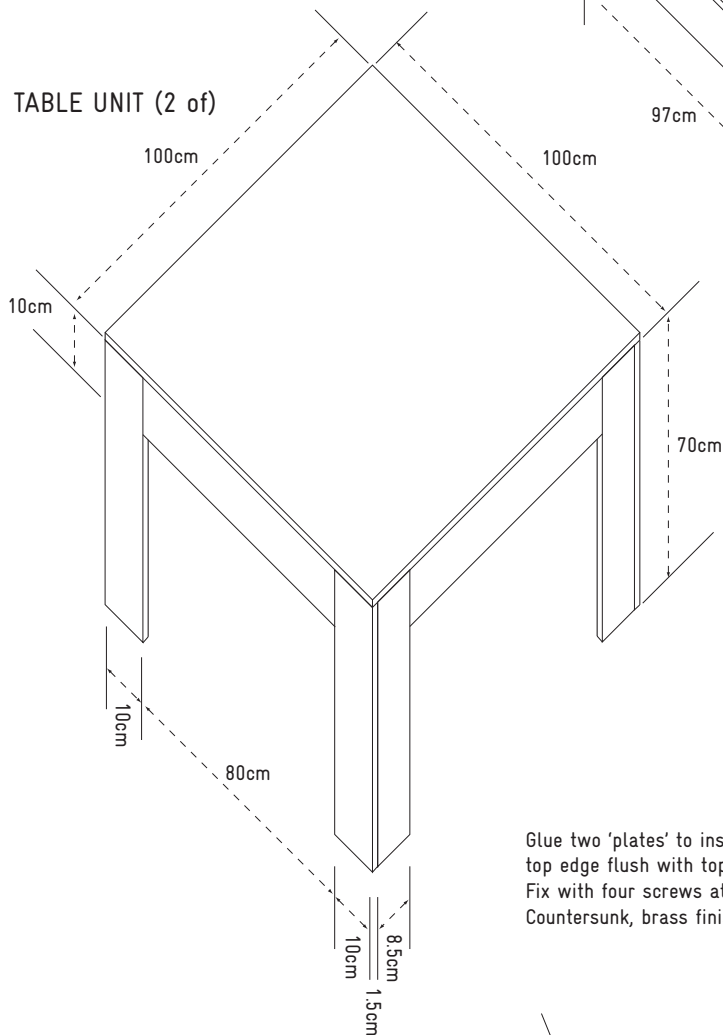


Table tops, glued onto frame,
no other fixing.

All faces and edges finished
with three coats of water based
matt clear varnish, applied with
a foam roller, lightly rubbed down
between each coat.

Bridging unit is bolted to
a table unit on two of its
opposite edges

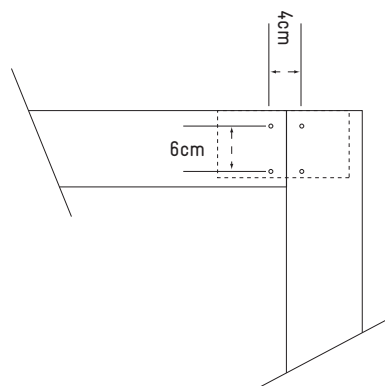
TABLE UNIT (2 of)



Legs formed from 2 strips, glued,
with hidden 8mm dowel joints (4 minimum).

Table edges joined to legs with
17cm x 9cm 'plates' glued and screwed
on rear face of side/leg joint.

Glue two 'plates' to inside of table frame at each corner,
top edge flush with top edge of leg/side strip.
Fix with four screws at each edge/leg joint
Countersunk, brass finish, no. 10, 25mm



CUTTING LIST - 15mm MDF

For 2 TABLES and 1 BRIDGING UNIT

A - tops, 3 of 100cm x 100cm

B - long sides, 8 of 10cm x 80cm

C - short sides, 2 of 10cm x 100cm

D - inside short sides (Bridging Unit), 2 of 10cm x 97cm

E - legs, 12 of 10cm x 70cm

F - inside legs, 12 of 8.5cm x 70cm

G - 'plates', 24 of 17cm x 9cm
